Uninhabited Subspecialty Slots (Post-IMM)

For

General Medicine/General Surgery Residents

Residents doing Pre-IMM on NOC based Induction & committed to opt Un-inhabited Sub-Specialties

The sub-specialty induction for session Jan 2022 is completed and a few slots in uninhabited specialties are left vacant. As per PGMI policy, the regular PG residents (on PGMI pay roll) who have completed two years pre-IMM training as General Medicine / General Surgery resident (4 years program) or doing pre-IMM training on NOC based induction outside PGMI affiliated Hospitals and committed to opt Un-inhabited sub-specialty are allowed to opt these uninhabited sub-specialties slot.

For General Medicine /Surgery residents

The General Medicine /Surgery residents can do so after changing their specialty with CPSP, if they are interested.

It will be mandatory to take NOC from present supervisor & Associate Dean/Head of Institute before coming for Interview.

This will be the responsibility of PG resident to change the specialty by CPSP and if any problem occurs in this process, PGMI will not be responsible for it.

It may not be possible to reclaim your General Medicine / General Surgery slot if CPSP refuse to change your specialty.

The stipend will be stopped on 30th June 2022 on completion of 24 month in General Medicine / General Surgery training and will start from the date of arrival in new specialty upon issue of RTMC by CPSP.

Any penalty imposed by CPSP for this change will be responsibility of the resident.

In case applicants are more than the available slot, merit-based selection will be made.

PROCEDURE & SCHEDULE: All interested residents are directed to come in person to PGMI at 10 am on Sunday 3rd July 2022.
