## SUB-SPECIALTY INDUCTION SESSION JULY 22 (MEDICINE & ALLIED) (SURGERY & ALLIED)

(For Inductees of July 2020 or completed 2 years pre-IMM and on Payroll of PGMI Peshawar)

You were provisionally allotted slot as per your merit and choice in Feb 2022 (list is already uploaded with merit number and provisionally allotted slot). For ready reference link is given below:

Those who want to continue with their provisional slot, will get placement order for it as final slot allocation, they DO NOT have to do anything. Those who want to change it for any reason, are allowed to do so as per following procedure. They have to come to PGMI office in person or through a representative to surrender their provisional slot and then they will be eligible for the interview on date and time mentioned below (same day surrender and same day re-interview and final slot allocation). All vacant slot (vacated by these residents, already vacant and slots in newly recognized unit) will be available to these residents. List is available at the end of this update.

This interview will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at PGMI Peshawar office. Those who are interested should come at 9 am. The registration will close at 10 am and NO ONE WILL BE ENTERTAINED ONCE REGTRATION IS CLOSED.

Be aware,

- It will NOT be possible to re-claim your vacated slot in case you fail to get slot of your choice.
- If someone chooses a specialty for which his rotations are not complete as per CPSP criteria and get refusal from CPSP or penalty for that deficiency, PGMI will not be responsible.

- All those who have some break in the training due to leave/maternity leave and their pre-IMM training will complete a few months later then their batch (after 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022), are required to appear in this interview.
- The Final Merit list of eligible PG residents for this interview is already uploaded on PGMI web site and Facebook page and link is given above.
- For Uninhabited specialties, please see the Induction Policy for FCPS-II for session July 2022, available on PGMI web site. For ready reference, these are Medical oncology, Neurology, Pulmonology, Nephrology & Clinical Hematology (AFBMTC has requested PGMI to induct 4 trainees as per merit and that has been done) and Cardiac surgery & Thoracic surgery. NOC based induction will be allowed in these specialties as per policy.
- As per standard policy, those who are unable to come for interview in person, can appear through a representative. The representative must bring authority letter that contains your name, CNIC number & your signature and Name and CNIC number of representatives; Representative must have copy of your CNIC and his Original CNIC for identification.
- All those who are relieved by PGMI from training or resigned from training, are NOT eligible for this interview. They can apply in general induction as per policy.
- If anybody who has registered (on the same day by surrendering his previous slot) but comes late for interview, he will be allowed to choose out of available vacant slots at that time. Please be in time.
- Please continue to view the PGMI website <u>www.pgmi.edu.pk</u> for any further updates / information in this regard.
- On arrival at PGMI, please register yourself with Mr. Shah Fahad at Conference room near Library.

Once unit/specialty is allocated to you as per your choice and merit, you will not be allowed to reapply in next session i.e., Jan 2023 general induction. It is further clarified that anybody who gets slot allocated whether he opt to join or not or resign at any stage, he will not be eligible for induction in next session. There will be no option to surrender the slot once allotted.

**ARRIVAL REPORTS**: The selected PG residents will be required to submit arrival between 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> July in their allotted Units and submit CPSP RTMC step-II form till 10<sup>th</sup> July. Detailed instruction will be given along with Placement order. The slot allocation will stands cancelled in respect of those who fails to submit arrival report and RTMC Step-II form in above given time.

If some slots fall vacant due to resign or not joining of resident, will be offered to leftovers eligible PG residents if any.

## POLICY REGARDING CHANGE OF SPECIALTY (Medicine & Allied and Surgery & Allied):

<u>Specialty to General</u>: As per decision of Executive Committee, if slots are less than the applicants in the group, the leftover will be allowed to continue as General Medicine (4 yrs. program).

<u>General to Specialty</u>: If some slots of sub-specialty (only UNINHABITED SPECIALTIES) left vacant in PGMI affiliated Institutions after the sub-Specialty induction (regular PGs and those who applied in general induction), the trainees of General Medicine who have completed two years training in General Medicine, may be allowed to change specialty to join that left over slots of sub-specialty. The NOC based induction will not be allowed.

It is pertinent to mention that they will not be allowed to change specialty later on. It is also clarified that it's prerogative of CPSP to approve these changes and PGMI will allow to change only in that case when CPSP has given the permission for such change. At any stage, if CPSP regrets, PGMI will not be responsible for any inconvenience.

<u>The list of vacant slots</u> is given below. The units / slot marked with \* and number of slots shown as – negative number means- slot in these units decreased due to some reasons and those who have already allotted slots in these units must come to PGMI on above mentioned time and date to have re-allocation or settlement of the issue. Please check website a day before the interview date for latest slot position.
